

1. Find a person who has been to at least three other states, other than his/her own. List which ones they were.
2. Find a classmate who knows how to sew on a button. Get him/her to explain how.
3. Find a person who visited a National Park this past summer. Ask which one.
4. Find a classmate who knows how to make pancakes. Ask him/her to explain the procedure.
5. Find someone who can count to 50 in another language. Make sure he/she can!
6. Find a classmate who has at least three "e"s or "a"s in his/her names. Get the entire name.
7. Find a classmate whose street address has a name that contains an "m". Ask for the name of the street.
8. Find a classmate who knows how to do a magic trick. Ask him/her to show or explain it to you.
9. Find a classmate who has visited an island. Ask him/her to name the island.
10. Find someone who visited an art gallery or a museum during his/her summer vacation. Ask which one.
11. Find someone who hates roller coasters or another fair ride. Ask that person why.
12. Find a person who has 3 or more siblings. Ask if they are older or younger, and get their names.
13. Find a classmate whose favorite color is either brown, turquoise, orange, or purple. Find out what colors he/she doesn't like.
14. Find a classmate who has lived in a big city (or if you are currently in a big city, then find a classmate who has lived on a farm). Ask where, and for how long.
15. Find someone who has had a weird pet. Ask what kind of animal it was - dogs, cats, guinea pigs not allowed.
16. Find a person who owns a pair of red shoes. Ask if they have any other colors as well.
17. Find a classmate who plays drums. Ask what his/her favorite song is.
18. Find someone who has tried lychee fruit, star fruit, guava, or prickly pears. Ask which one, when, and if he/she liked it.
19. Find a person who has attended a symphony concert. Ask which one, and when.
20. Find a classmate who has a waveboard. Ask him/her how long he/she has been waveboarding.
