Pass out some Easter egg templates first, then have your students draw a design with crayons. Use lots of colors and make a good portion of the eggs designed with crayons. You will then be painting across the entire egg with pastel colored tempera paint - offer yellow, pink, purple, pale blue or green, etc. Make sure your tempera is fairly watery - it tends to coat everything if it's too thick.
